


#### COLOR










#### THE MATERIALS

#### tweed

Blending heritage charm with modern sophistication, tweed is about rich texture, timeless elegance, and a sense of "quiet luxury." Expect to see coordinated sets featuring tweed blazers with matching skirts (mini, midi, or even maxi), or tweed trousers (straight-leg or wide-leg). Tweed is being reimagined in tailored suits, moving beyond traditional menswear to offer sophisticated options for all.



## sequin

Sequins are no longer reserved for special occasions, now seen in everyday wear for a touch of unexpected glam. The key is to pair them with casual, even "rugged," pieces to create a dynamic contrast.
