


THE SILHOUETTE









THE BLOUSE

•A key piece in womenswear with sculptural volumes that incorporates texture and movement through ruffles, draping, ruching and voluminous sleeves. Designs are reimagined through layers of sheer and cutouts.

THE 90's SHIRT

•The 90's inspired shirt, gains traction with the popularity of modern tailoring and workwear. Sophisticated materials, straight cuts, structured shoulders in white, blue, soft pinks and butter yellow create a soft and sophisticated appeal.







THE KNITTED VEST

•Knitted vest are gaining traction again with the preppy aesthetic from recent seasons. Look for knits in looser silhouettes, neutral shades, dressier fabrications and designs geared towards workwear but still very prevalent to the Urban Prairie aesthetic.

THE CARGO PANT

•With a focus on streetwear, cargo pants have evolved with major updates from purely utilitarian to more fashionable, softer interpretations in reimagined refined fabrics. While baggy styles remain, there's a rise in more structured and tailored cargo pants. Think slimmer fits, pleats, and sharper lines that offer a more polished appearance. Added trims such as metal zippers, cords and rings as well as prints, and elevated looks for a dressier appearance finds the balance between practicality and style.







THE LEATHER PANT

•Offering a blend of edgy sophistication and versatile styling options, leather pants are emerging as a key material for women's trousers. From wide legs and relaxed fits, to subtle flares and cropped lengths in sophisticated textures and finishes. Expect to see this fall staple layered in classic black, earthy tones and neutrals paired with unexpected pieces.







THE BERMUDA SHORT

•Continuing their stylish evolution beyond just summer wear. The key to this trend is sophistication and versatility, allowing them to transition seamlessly into cooler weather. Expect Bermuda shorts crafted from traditional suiting fabrics like wool blends, tweed, or crisp cotton twill. They often come with pleats, sharp creases, and a well-defined waistband, mirroring the look of tailored trousers.







THE TROUSER

•From the continued popularity of wide-leg silhouettes to the refined evolution of leather and cargo pants, and a more considered approach to cropped lengths; the trouser offers a diverse range of styling. Tailored fits, activewear details, crisp pleats and extra long puddle silhouettes in luxurious fabrics create a relaxed vibe with a modern twist. Subtle prints and texture add depth, elevating the various style options.

THE MAXI

•Evolving with fresh silhouettes, rich textures, and sophisticated styling maxi skirts offers a streamlined look and elongates the figure. Look for subtle side slits, back vents, or minimal seaming to add movement and interest without disrupting the clean line. Pair them with chunky knit sweaters, delicate silk blouses, or tailored blazers for a high-contrast look. Subtle bohemian influences like tiered designs or gentle gathers might appear, offering a more relaxed, artistic flair, often paired with oversized tops or vintage-inspired pieces.







THE MINI

•Lean heavily into structured and tailored designs. Think clean lines, sharp A-line silhouettes, and even subtle pleats. These are designed to be more polished and less overtly "teeny." Expect to see it crafted from rich leathers, tweed, satin and denim layered over sheer tights, patterned stockings, or even very thin leggings for added warmth and stylistic flair.







THE MIDI

•The pencil skirt is making a powerful comeback, particularly in its midi length. A more dramatic trend emerging is the poufy midi skirts with exaggerated volume, layers of tulle, or puffed-up hemlines will add a joyful and playful twist. This aligns with an overarching '80s theme seen on runways. Expect to see them in high-quality wool blends, refined leather (or faux leather), and even lace for a touch of ladylike elegance. Pair voluminous midi skirts with more fitted tops, or sleek pencil midis with oversized knitwear or blazers.







THE BUBBLE SKIRT

•Integrating the playful volume into a more refined, contemporary wardrobe statement, the volume is intentional and architectural, often achieved with internal netting, stiffer fabrics, or clever tailoring that cinches the hem to create the rounded effect. Crisp cottons and poplin are used to maintain the structure and shape of the bubble. Look for silks and satin for a dressier, more fluid, and luxurious feel, these fabrics elevate the bubble silhouette, making it suitable for evening wear or special occasions.

THE SHIRT DRESS

•Bridging the gap between casual comfort and polished sophistication, expect shirt dresses that are more structured than past seasons designs. Seen with sharper collars, defined shoulders and a cinched or tailored waist. High-quality cotton poplin, crisp twill, and even refined wool blends will give these dresses a more formal and elevated feel.







THE BOHO DRESS

•Refined, sophistication, and earthy interpretation that blends vintage soul with a modern edge. It's a reaction against extreme minimalism, seeking comfort, expression, and a connection to nature. Tiered ruffles and smocking, fluid drapes, sophisticated prints in rich textures and natural fabrics provide flow and movement. Earthy and warm color palettes add depth. Pair boho dresses with chunky knits, boots, and statement accessories.

THE SLIP DRESS

•Evolving from a purely minimalist piece to embrace more luxurious fabrics, thoughtful details, and versatile styling. Its inherent comfort and ability to be dressed up or down make it ideal for the season. Satin and silks are quintessential fabrics for the slip dress. Velvet is emerging for a richer, more autumnal take adding a plush texture, perfect for evening wear and holiday occasions. Expect to see it in various weights, from lightweight and fluid to slightly heavier, providing a more structured drape.







THE MAXI DRESS

•Richer fabrics, sophisticated silhouettes, and thoughtful styling moved beyond flowing bohemian styles, with more tailored elements. Think sharp collars, defined shoulders, and perhaps a subtle A-line or column cut that emphasizes structure. While structured styles are strong, the classic flowing maxi dress remains. The emphasis is on fluid fabrics (like washed silks, satins, or soft rayons) that drape beautifully, offering a sense of effortless elegance and movement.

THE BLAZER

•Blazers remain a non-negotiable wardrobe staple for Fall 2025, but their evolution focuses on refined silhouettes, luxurious textures, and versatile styling. They're no longer just for the office; they're integral to both polished professional looks and chic everyday ensembles. Oversized blazer remains the dominate silhouette for the season with a sophisticated and less sloppy feel. Structured shoulders will be key to maintain a powerful silhouette. Moving away from solely oversized, there's a strong resurgence of blazers with more defined, nipped-in waists. This sculpts the figure and offers a powerful, feminine silhouette.








THE BOMBER JACKET

•Evolving beyond its military roots to encompass a broader range of aesthetics, from utilitarian cool to luxurious statement pieces, expect to see bomber jackets crafted from rich, tactile fabrics that elevate their status. Leather and suede iterations will be prominent with a more refined finish. Oversized and slouchy bomber remains dominant while the cropped and boxy style gain significant traction. Textural interest and embellishment, furry and shearling accents incorporate a luxury aesthetics.







THE TRENCH

•This timeless staple consistently re-emerges with new interpretations. Focus on clean lines, precise construction, defined shoulders, belted waist in luxurious materials with leather trenches dominating the season. Layer with tailored suits, chunky sweaters, hoodies and blazers.







THE FUR COAT

•Faux fur in particular; moving away from overtly flashy or brightly colored faux fur, this trend focuses on sophisticated, rich textures that mimic real fur with incredible accuracy but in a more understated way. Clean lines, classic cuts (like straight, slightly A-line, or tailored overcoats), and minimal embellishment in natural color palettes contribute to a timeless and elegant feel. Beyond smooth, sleek faux fur, shaggy, fluffy, and high-pile textures are prominent, adding a playful and tactile dimension. Leopard, zebra, and even subtle tiger or giraffe prints continue to be a dominant force in faux fur.







THE OVERCOAT

•The ultimate statement piece for polished dressing and a symbol of sophisticated outerwear, the overcoat is a definitive trend for fall 2025. While still tailored, many overcoats will embrace a relaxed, slightly oversized fit. This allows for comfortable layering over suits, chunky knitwear, or even blazers without feeling restrictive. Even with a relaxed body, strong, defined shoulders (often with subtle padding) are key. This adds a sense of power and structure, giving the coat a commanding presence.







THE CAPE

•The cape's ability to transform an outfit, offers freedom of movement, and provide a dramatic visual impact ensures its place as a globally adaptable and an enduring fashion statement. Designers are experimenting with coats that feature traditional sleeves but with an additional cape-like overlay, or coats where the sleeves are integrated into the cape structure. This offers the warmth of a coat with the dramatic flair of a cape. For an edgy and modern take, leather or high-quality faux leather capes will offer a sleek, structured appearance, adding a contemporary coolness.

This season, details make the difference—transforming garments into statements of personality, purpose, and play. Fall/Winter 2025 embraces a rich vocabulary of embellishments and functional accents that speak to both romanticism and utility, structure and softness.








